Don’t miss an opportunity to pray, give, and go more in 2024!

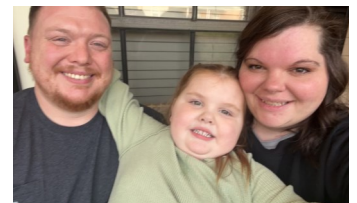
