## SOVEREIGN SETUP

Acts 10:1-23a

Sunday, August 4, 2024

**Gospel Truth: God intervenes in the lives of lost sinners and His servants for the good of others, the growth of the church, and the glory of His name.**

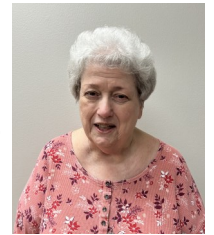
