

Budgets were mailed last week and are available in the sanctuary today.

In light of our Acts 1:8 missions strategy, the **Christmas Store this year is going local and global!** We will be providing 40 needy families in our community with food boxes substantial enough to feed their entire family a delicious meal around Christmas. In addition, we will be providing a Christian-based orphanage in Ecuador with pajamas for approximately 50 orphans and uniforms for around 20 workers. How can you participate? Beginning Sunday, November 12, you can pick up an envelope from a table in the sanctuary and return it no later than December 3 with the designated amount of money enclosed: \$30 uniforms, \$40 pajamas (2 pair), \$50 food box. In order to encourage church-wide participation, each church family should pick up only one envelope. The items will be purchased by church leadership. The delivery of pajamas and uniforms to the orphanage is expected to occur Christmas Day. Food boxes will be presented on our campus to needy families Saturday, December 9 at 9:00 and 9:45 a.m. Contact Michael Holyfield if you are interested in being an evangelism counselor for this ministry or helping with the assembly of the food boxes. If all goes as desired, we will have 110 church families reaching well over 150 needy people of all ages locally and internationally in Jesus' name. Let's give for God's glory!

For our Christmas program this year (Carol and the Belles), the children who aren't in costume will be wearing a **new Children's Choir t-shirt** that we just had designed. These shirts are \$10 each and can be ordered by scanning the QR code (pay when you pick up the shirt).
