## JEWS ENDORSE GOD'S SALVATION AMONG GENTILES

Acts 11:1-18

Sunday, August 25, 2024

**Gospel Truth: God orchestrated Jewish endorsement of His saving work among Gentiles.**

The apostles and other believing Jews throughout Judea heard that \_\_\_\_\_ had repented and believed in Jesus.
